**AFFIDAVIT OF RICHARD GOLDGLASS
(sworn September 17, 2025)**

I, RICHARD GOLDGLASS, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, **MAKE
OATH AND SAY:**

1. I was an employee of Synaptive Medical Inc. ("**Synaptive**") until I was terminated on June 16, 2025.
2. As set out further below, I have claims for an unpaid bonus, pay in lieu of notice of termination, and severance, which have not been paid.
3. I have also not received any payment from the government, via the Wage Earner Protection Program ("**WEPP**"). To date, I have only received employment insurance benefits. While it has been three months for me, it has been longer for other terminated Synaptive employees. I support the motion filed by Synaptive to obtain WEPP payments to me and other terminated employees and add that due to the subsequent bankruptcy of Synaptive Medical Holdings Inc., WEPP now automatically applies and the employees should be able to obtain a WEPP payment.

4. I started working with Synaptive on May 16, 2018, as a Senior Recruitment Specialist. In October 2021, I was promoted to the position of a Human Resources Director. I remained in that position until I was terminated on June 16, 2025. I have worked in the human resources field for approximately 20 years.

5. I have a Bachelor of Arts in psychology from the University of Western Ontario, and a Bachelor of Arts in information technology from York University.

6. Where the facts set out in this Affidavit are based on information provided to me by others, I have set out the source of the information and verily believe it to be true.

Synaptive's proceeding under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act and the termination of employees

7. Synaptive is a medical technology company. Based on my review of Ontario's corporate registry, Synaptive was incorporated in Ontario on April 30, 2012. Synaptive is a supplier of products to support neurosurgery patients for surgical procedures.

8. Synaptive is the parent of several subsidiary companies located in the United States, Barbados, Europe, and Australia. (together with Synaptive, the "**Synaptive Group**").

9. As of March 14, 2025, the Synaptive Group had 189 hourly and salaried employees across Canada, the United States, and other countries.

10. It is my belief, based mostly by reading the CCAA materials, that over the past several years, Synaptive has had financial challenges due to sales pressures, rising research and development costs and other pressures.

11. On March 4, 2025, I was instructed by Synaptive management to temporarily layoff 149 employees. I placed these employees on temporary layoff and sent them a layoff notice.

12. On March 19, 2025, Synaptive obtained protection from its creditors under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, RSC 1985, c C-36 ("**CCAA**"). Richter Inc. was appointed as the CCAA Monitor. I remained in my position following the CCAA filing.

13. Approximately two weeks after Synaptive obtained CCAA protection, I was instructed by management to terminate 70 employees who were on temporary layoff (the "**Terminated Employees**"). A copy of the termination notice I sent those employees, dated March 20, 2025, is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"**.

14. On March 24, 2025, Synaptive recalled to work the remaining 79 of its temporarily laid off employees.

15. On June 16, 2025, I was terminated by Synaptive without being paid my 2023 bonus, pay in lieu of statutory termination notice, and severance. My termination letter, dated June 19, 2025 is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"**.

16. Synaptive did not pay the Terminated Employees wages for work performed, pay in lieu of notice of termination, vacation pay, bonuses, and expense reimbursements (the "**Employee Amounts**").

17. The Terminated Employees are facing significant financial hardships due to the loss of our jobs without being paid the Employee Amounts.

18. I believe that the Terminated Employees have a total claim of over \$1.1 million in respect of the Employee Amounts. This amount is approximately broken down as follows: \$85,000 in respect of unpaid wages accrued within six months prior to termination, \$98,000 in respect of unpaid vacation pay accrued within six months prior to termination, \$308,000 in respect of unpaid vacation pay and other expense accrued over six months prior to termination, \$324,000 in respect of statutory pay in lieu of termination notice, and \$251,000 in respect of unpaid severance pay. I am advised by my counsel, Andrew J. Hatnay of Koskie Minsky LLP ("**KM**"), and believe him that approximately \$101,000 is a priority claim for the Terminated Employees. The Employee Amounts should also include claims for common law termination pay in lieu of notice and an amount for compensation for our terminated health and other benefits during the notice period.

19. According to the Fourth Report of the Monitor, para. 6.8, dated July 28, 2025, which I have reviewed, the Monitor estimates approximately \$101,000 will be paid to the Terminated Employees in respect of the priority claim. However, the Terminated Employees are not expected to receive any distribution payment in respect of their unsecured claim in the approximate amount of \$1 million.

20. Based on my review of the CCAA materials filed in this proceeding, the Terminated Employees appear to be a substantial creditor group.

21. Importantly, the Terminated Employees have claims for actual unpaid work – not simply notice damages stemming from their termination. For example, many of the Terminated Employees are owed around two weeks' worth of earned wages for which they have not been paid.

22. In addition, I, along with several other employees were not paid our bonuses under the 2023 Synaptive Medical Bonus Plan. That plan states that the amount of our bonus has two

components. The individual component of our bonus is to "be paid even if the Company financial targets are not met." Despite reaching my employee performance goals, I did not receive the individual component of my bonus. A copy of the 2023 Synaptive Medical Bonus Plan is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"**.

WEPP is the only source of compensation for the Terminated Employees

23. After the company obtained CCAA protection on March 19, 2025, the Monitor sent the Terminated Employees a "Notice of Wage Earner Protection Program Act", dated April 17, 2025 which informed us of the federal WEPP and the potential of receiving a payment of up to \$8,844.22 toward our claims in respect of the Employee Amounts. The Notice stated that "[t]he Monitor understands that certain amounts owed to you have not been paid. As such, the Monitor has filed a proof of claim on your behalf, with respect to any amounts owed to you in respect of wages, vacation, termination and severance pay, if applicable". A copy of that Notice dated April 17, 2025, is attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"**.

24. I was later informed by Mr. Hatnay, and I believe that the *Wage Earner Protection Program Act*, SC 2005, c 47 ("**WEPPA**") is not automatically applicable to CCAA proceedings and requires a court order to be made applicable.

25. I am further advised by Mr. Hatnay and believe that to date, there has been no court order finding that WEPPA applies to the Synaptive CCAA proceeding.

26. Consequently, the Terminated Employees have not received *any* payment in respect of our claims in respect of the Employee Amounts for over the past six months.

The bankruptcy of Synaptive Medical Holdings

27. Under CCAA protection, Synaptive reorganized itself through a sales process which involves a "reverse vesting order". On March 26, 2025, the Ontario Superior Court of Justice (Commercial List) issued an order sought by the company that approved a sale and investment solicitation process ("**SISP**") in respect of Synaptive and/or its assets. By mid-June, the SISP concluded and a successful bidder was selected (the "**Purchaser**").

28. The sales process followed a "reverse vesting order" structure: Synaptive and the Purchaser then entered into a Subscription Agreement where 100% of the shares of Synaptive were acquired by the Purchaser. As part of the transaction, Synaptive incorporated another company named Synaptive Medical Holdings Inc. or 1001253954 Ontario Inc. ("**Synaptive Medical Holdings**"). Attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"** is a copy of the corporate search for Synaptive Medical Holdings. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "F"** of copy of the corporate search for Synaptive.

29. Under the sales transaction, Synaptive transferred various liabilities to its newly created company, Synaptive Medical Holdings, which the purchaser did not acquire. The sales transaction also contemplated that Synaptive would be removed as a CCAA applicant and replaced by Synaptive Medical Holdings. On June 18, 2025, Synaptive brought a motion seeking the Approval and Reverse Vesting Order, which the Court granted

30. That same day, Synaptive also requested a CCAA Stay Extension and Termination Order, which sought an order that Synaptive met the criteria prescribed by section 3.2 of the *Wage Earner Protection Program Regulations*, SOR/2008-222, and it also requested the Court's approval to authorize Synaptive Medical Holdings to assign itself into bankruptcy. The Court granted the requested orders.

31. Prior to the court hearing on June 18, 2025, the Attorney General of Canada ("**AGC**") filed an Aide Memoire on June 17, 2025 opposing the WEPPA relief sought arguing that the Court should not grant a WEPPA order because the company's sales transaction is a "reverse vesting order ("RVO") which is contrary to the intention and purpose of the WEPP". The AGC requested that the WEPPA relief be withdrawn or that full hearing be scheduled to determine the issue.

32. Synaptive adjourned the WEPPA related relief on June 18, 2025.

33. On July 28, 2025, Synaptive Medical Holdings brought a motion to terminate the CCAA proceeding upon the filing of a certificate by the Monitor, and to schedule a motion for an order that Synaptive meets the criteria prescribed by section 3.2 of the WEPP Regulations (the "**WEPP Motion**"). The Court approved the Termination and Scheduling Order on August 6, 2025 and scheduled the WEPP Motion to be returnable on November 12, 2025.

34. On September 3, 2025, following the Termination and Scheduling Order, Synaptive Medical Holdings made an assignment in bankruptcy under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, RSC 1985, c B-3. The firm of Bricks and Damiani Inc. is the trustee in bankruptcy. A copy of the Notice of Bankruptcy and First Meeting of Creditors, dated September 8, 2025, is attached hereto as **Exhibit "G"**.

35. According to the Notice of Bankruptcy and First Meeting of Creditors, dated September 8, 2025, Synaptive Medical Holdings has liabilities in excess of \$137 million and virtually no assets. As such, the Terminated Employees are expected to receive no payment in respect of their Employee Amounts claims.

The subsequent bankruptcy of Synaptive Medical Holdings makes WEPPA automatically applicable

36. I am advised by Mr. Hatnay and believe him that pursuant to section 5(1)(b)(i) of WEPPA, WEPP is automatically applicable to a proceeding where terminated employees are owed claims by a bankrupt entity:

5(1) An individual is eligible to receive a payment if

...

(b) one of the following applies:

(i) the former employer is **bankrupt**,

...

[emphasis added]

37. Unlike a CCAA proceeding, a court order is not required for WEPPA to be applicable for terminated employees in a bankruptcy. Due to the bankruptcy of Synaptive Medical Holdings, WEPPA is automatically applicable, and the Terminated Employees should be able to apply to receive a WEPP payment.

38. The Terminated Employees are in urgent need of a WEPP payment.

39. I swear this Affidavit in good faith and in support of:

- A) the motion brought by Synaptive for an order declaring that the company meets the criteria prescribed by section 3.2 of the WEPP Regulations and in addition,
- B) b) a direction or order from the Court that the Terminated Employees are eligible to receive a WEPP payment due to the bankruptcy of Synaptive Medical Holdings, and for no improper purpose.

This will confirm our conversation on June 16, 2025 wherein you were advised that your employment with Synaptive Medical Inc. (the "Company") was ending effective immediately. The decision to end your employment is on a without cause basis. Please note the following:

(a) **Outstanding Wages and Vacation Pay:** You will receive a lump sum payment of \$2,558.72 CAD, in satisfaction of all outstanding wages and 28.78 hours of unused vacation pay.

(b) **Benefit Coverage:** All aspects of your benefit coverage will continue for a period expiring June 30, 2025. As always, your participation remains subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable plans (as defined by contract and our carrier), including the term that your coverage will end if you commence other employment. You will also be subject to any changes to our policy that may come into effect after today.

You have certain conversion privileges with respect to your life insurance. You will have 31 days from the date that your life insurance coverage ends to convert this insurance to your own personal coverage at your own expense. Please contact Richard Goldglass should you wish to arrange for such conversion. If you fail to arrange for such conversion, your life insurance coverage will end.

(c) **Business Expenses:** The Company will reimburse you for any allowable business expenses incurred by you in connection with your ongoing duties and responsibilities, and in accordance with the Company's policies and practices, provided you complete and deliver all supporting documentation to the undersigned no later than 15 calendar days after the date your employment ends.

(d) **Record of Employment and T4:** Your Record of Employment will be issued in due course, and any applicable T4 slips will be provided electronically when they become available. Please notify us of any address changes.

(e) **Ongoing Obligations:** Nothing in the preceding paragraphs shall negate, affect or impair any obligations that you may owe to the Company at common law, under statute and/or pursuant to the terms of any agreements you signed prior to or during your employment, including any confidentiality, non-solicitation and non-competition restrictions. In that regard, other than on behalf of and for the benefit of the Company you shall not use, copy or disclose any of the Company's Proprietary Information, as that term is defined in your Employee Confidentiality and Assignment Agreement.

In connection with the foregoing, on or before June 23, 2025 you are required to return to the Company all property relating to or belonging to the Company including, without limitation, any computers, laptops, computer software, cameras, cell phones, smart phones, scanners, credit cards, keys, passwords, access codes and any other documents or information and all copies thereof, in any format whatsoever, including electronic format, that is in your possession or control.

In addition, it has come to our attention that you have been sending messages to existing Synaptive employees that (a) contain vulgar, personal attacks, and/or (b) contain inaccurate and/or confidential information about Synaptive that is intended to create an unhappy work environment or discourage employees from remaining with the Company. This behaviour is inappropriate and harmful to Synaptive's operations, and you are hereby put on notice that if such activity does not cease immediately Synaptive will not hesitate to pursue any available legal remedies.

We thank you for your service to the Company, and we wish you the best in your future endeavours.

2023 Synaptive Medical Bonus Plan

Introduction

The Annual Bonus Plan gives employees the opportunity to share in Synaptive's success. Eligible plan participants include all permanent employees who are not currently registered with any other incentive plans such as our commission program for sales representatives.

The Plan is effective from January 1 to December 31 and cancels, supersedes and replaces any and all prior individual compensation plans. Payment, if any, will be made following the announcement of annual results the following year.

Definitions

Currency: Synaptive financials and bonus financial measures are recorded in US dollars. Bonus payouts will be made in local currency.

Plan Year: A 12-month period during which the Plan applies. Synaptive Plan Years run January to December.

Target: The objective/targets are set at the beginning of the year. This target includes revenue and adjusted EBITDA.

Multiplier: The multiplier value is based on the level of target achievement. There is a linear relationship between threshold milestones.

Adjusted EBITDA: Earnings before interest, tax, depreciation, and amortization (EBITDA) is a measure of a company's operating performance. Adjusted EBITDA will exclude the following items: stock-based compensation; impairments; fair value adjustments; direct financing costs; direct M&A costs; significant unusual legal events; and other significant, unusual items as determined by the Board of Directors and excludes bonus expense.

Target Bonus Opportunity (TBO)

With respect to each eligible employee, a target bonus opportunity is expressed as a percentage of the employee's annual base salary. The TBO is intended to reflect the bonus payment that would be paid if performance goals and other expectations are met at the 100% level by both the eligible employee and the company.

The Target Bonus Opportunity consists of two components of measurement: an Individual Component relating to your personal performance, and a Company Component reflecting our overall performance as a team against our revenue and Adjusted EBITDA targets.

Individual Component %	Company Component %

Individual Component

Individual goals will be measured at the end of each Plan Year with performance evaluations. The size of the Individual Component payout of your annual bonus will depend on how well you have performed against your individual goals agreed with your manager. Your Individual Component payout may be less than or equal to 100% of your Individual Component target above. The Individual Component of the bonus will be paid even if the Company financial targets are not met.

Company Component

Based on the Company's performance against the Revenue Target and Adjusted EBITDA Target, you will be eligible to receive a payout of the Company Component. The table below indicates our 2023 Revenue & Adjusted EBITDA Targets and the bonus payout impact of our performance against these targets. Note that there is an increase to the payout of the Company Component if the Company outperforms either or both the Revenue and Adjusted EBITDA



Targets. The minimum Revenue threshold must be met to attain eligibility for payout of the Revenue Company Component. Separately, the minimum EBITDA threshold must be met to attain eligibility for payout of the Adjusted EBITDA Company Component. Neither, either, or both the Revenue and Adjusted EBITDA components may be paid out.

The Revenue and Adjusted EBITDA targets are set forth below. The multiplier will be expressed as a percentage of the Revenue and Adjusted EBITDA targets, separately, up to a maximum of 150% of each measure.

The targets below constitute our internal targets only and is Confidential Information. The Confidential Information may not be copied, transmitted, or otherwise distributed, in whole or in part.

Target Bonus Payouts are calculated as a percent of annual base salary. This does not include any other types of compensation, including bonus payments, commissions, overtime pay, or equity-related payments. If you receive a salary change during the Plan Year, the Company will pro-rate by the number of whole months at each salary level.

Total Bonus Award

Individual Bonus Award + Company Bonus Award = Total Bonus Award

Individual Bonus Award Calculation

Base Salary x TBO x Individual Component Weight x Individual Achievement = Individual Bonus Award

Company Bonus Award Calculation

Revenue calculation

Base Salary x TBO x Revenue Weight x Revenue Multiplier = Revenue Bonus Award

Adjusted EBITDA calculation

Base Salary x TBO x Adjusted EBITDA Weight x Adjusted EBITDA Multiplier = Adjusted EBITDA Bonus Award

Example

In this example, assume you are an individual contributor with a base salary of \$75,000, and a ten percent (10%) target bonus opportunity (TBO). Target Revenue is \$37M and Target Adjusted EBITDA is a loss of \$23M. The minimum threshold for Revenue is \$25M with a stretch target of \$43M+. The Adjusted EBITDA threshold is a loss of \$31M with a stretch target of a loss of \$19M. You are a strong performer and met goals. Let's assume the company revenue in 2023 is \$35M and our Adjusted EBITDA comes in at a loss of \$18M. Your bonus would be \$7,686. Here's how:

For Individual Component:

Base Salary x TBO x Individual Component x Individual Achievement = Individual Component Bonus Award
 75,000 x 10% x 20% x 100% = \$1,500

For Revenue Component:

Base Salary x TBO x Revenue Component x Revenue Achievement = Revenue Component Bonus Award
 75,000 x 10% x 50% x 83% = \$3,113

For Adjusted EBITDA Component:

Base Salary x TBO x Adjusted EBITDA Component x Adjusted EBITDA Achievement = Adjusted EBITDA Component Bonus Award
 75,000 x 10% x 30% x 150% = \$3,375

Total Award:

Individual Component Bonus Award + (Revenue Component Bonus Award + Adjusted EBITDA Component Bonus Award) = Total Bonus Award
 \$1,500 + \$3,113 + \$3,375 = \$7,988

Participation

Participation in this Plan does not create a contract of employment or guarantee any right of continuing employment in your current job or any other job with the Company. You acknowledge and agree that the restrictions and obligations in this Plan are separate from and independent of any employment agreements between you and Synaptive Medical, and that termination of your employment shall not, under any circumstances, terminate, invalidate, or limit your obligations under this Plan. The Company may cancel or change your participation in the Plan at any time at its sole discretion, consistent with applicable employment laws.

Plan Interpretations and Modifications

The Company is responsible for interpreting provisions of the Plan. The Company reserves the right to adjust incentive amounts at its sole discretion. Such adjustments may result from, but are not limited to, overall business performance and the equity of awards. The Company also reserves the right to amend or discontinue the Plan at any time.

Accounting Policy Changes or Addition of New Business Units

In the event of accounting policy changes, the Company Revenue or Adjusted EBITDA targets may change. The Bonus Plan and/or financial results related to the Plan may be updated to reflect these changes.

Change in Eligibility Status

If an employee becomes or ceases to be eligible for the Plan during the Plan Year, the employee will receive a prorated award for the portion of the plan year during which employee was eligible for an award, provided that the employee is with Synaptive at the time the bonus is paid. The employee award will be paid on the normal payment date.

Involuntary Termination With or Without Cause

Should an employee be terminated prior to the bonus payment date, bonus will be prorated for the months completed and paid the following year once it has been confirmed that targets have been met.



Voluntary Termination (Resignation)

Should an employee leave the employment of Synaptive Medical voluntarily prior to the last working day of the Plan Year, bonus eligibility shall be forfeited, and no payment will be made.

Disablement and Death

Should an employee become disabled or die during the Plan Year, a prorated payment will be made if targets are met. The employee award will be paid on the normal payment date.

Non-Assignability

Prior to its payment in cash, no right or benefit under this Plan shall be subject to anticipation, alienation, sale, assignment, pledge, encumbrance, or charge. Any attempt to anticipate, alienate, sell, assign, pledge, encumber or charge the same whether voluntary, involuntary or by operation of law, shall be void except by will or by the laws of descent and distribution or by such other means as the administrator may approve from time to time.

Severability

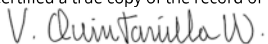

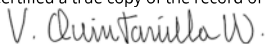

The creditor's mailing address **must** be given to allow the LIT to distribute any estate funds.

- This can be the creditor or the name or position of a creditor representative.
- A telephone number for the contact person can be given for communication with the LIT.

Additional Details

Enter the following:

- Select if the claim relates to a bankruptcy, a proposal or a receivership.

- The city and province of the debtor.
- The full legal name of the creditor.

The type of proceeding and the name and city of the debtor may be pre-filled by the LIT.
